



Fityouth ANAC India Aerobic Gymnastics National Level Judges Course and Coaches Clinic drew GFI experts and FIG Level 3 Coaches and International Judges of Aerobic Gymnastics to prepare, conduct and deliver this course congruently with their knowledge and expertise.

2. Theoretical Sessions

The theoretical sessions witnessed knowledge leaders such as Mr Narayan Shashi, Mr. Sunil Chhetri and Mr. Anoop Gurung who shared the technical insights in different categories of judging Aerobic Gymnastics namely Difficulty, Execution, Artistic and Chair of Judges Panel. Each session was precise, updated with latest FIG Code of Points 2017-2020 and divided into smaller units for easy comprehension.

3. Practical Sessions

The four days of course was designed to include practical sessions as well to give hands -on experience to participants for technical skills learned in theoretical sessions. Practical Sessions were given sequentially in Artistic category to include Basic Steps/AMP/General Content, in Difficulty (A, B, C, D), Execution and C.IP

4. Video Analysis and Practice

Video Analysis sessions proved beneficial to participants where they get ample time to practice judging the sample routines of Aerobic Gymnastics in Artistic, Difficulty, Execution and CJP category

5. Theory and Practical Exam

Last day of the event was crucial as the Theory Exam and Practical Exam was conducted to test the skills that participants had learnt

Certificates of Course Completion is awarded to all the participants who has completed the course and Brevet Levels were given to those after scrutinizing the Theory and Practical Exam score sheets of participants
